

Raincoat Instructions

I. Product Introduction

1. Material: Oxford cloth and polyester fiber composite waterproof
2. This product is an outdoor raincoat made of high-density waterproof fabric, with sealed seams and a windproof hood design. It has excellent waterproof and windproof performance, while the fabric is lightweight, breathable, wear-resistant, wrinkle-resistant, and easy to store and carry. It is an ideal rain gear for daily travel and outdoor commuting.
3. Suitable for daily commutes, cycling, hiking, and other scenarios, it can be used in light to moderate rain and strong winds, providing comprehensive rain protection. Suitable for adults and children. Not suitable for extreme weather conditions such as heavy rain, thunderstorms, and strong typhoons.
4. Place of Origin: Ningbo City, Zhejiang Province, Mainland China

II. Instructions for Use

Usage Instructions:

1. Take out the raincoat, unfold it flat, and distinguish the front from the back to avoid putting it on inside out.
2. Reach your hands into the sleeves and pull the raincoat up to your shoulders. Adjust the sleeves to fit snugly against your body, ensuring there are no tangles or wrinkles.
3. Put on the hood, adjust the brim to cover your head, and pull the drawstring to tighten it until it fits snugly against your head, preventing rainwater from seeping in from your neck and forehead.

Storage Instructions:

1. After use, gently shake off any rainwater from the surface of the raincoat and hang it in a well-ventilated area to air dry naturally. Avoid folding and storing it while it is

still damp.

2. After drying, lay the raincoat flat, fold the sleeves inwards, and fold the hem upwards until it is level with your shoulders, shaping it into a neat rectangle.

III. Safety Warnings

1. This product is not lightning protection. Do not stay or use it outdoors at high altitudes, under tall trees, or near utility poles during thunderstorms to avoid the risk of lightning strikes.

2. When riding, tighten the hem and cuffs of the raincoat to prevent clothing from getting caught in the wheels or chain. Pay attention to traffic safety.

3. Do not disassemble or modify the raincoat's sealing structure, as this will cause waterproofing failure and affect its safety.

IV. Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q: What to do if your raincoat leaks water?

A: First, check the location of the water seepage. If the water seeps from the stitches, it may be due to the heat sealant coming off. You can apply special waterproof glue to repair it. If the water seeps from a tear in the fabric, small holes can be repaired with waterproof tape.

2. Q: How to solve the problem of waterproof zippers not pulling smoothly or getting stuck?

A: Wipe the zipper surface with a dry cloth to remove dust and debris, and prevent foreign objects from getting stuck. If the zipper is rusty or dry, you can apply a small amount of zipper lubricant.

3. Q: What to do if the adjusting buckle or drawstring is loose or broken?

A: If the adjusting buckle is loose, gently press the buckle to tighten it; if the drawstring is loose, re-tie it to secure it; if the adjusting buckle or drawstring is broken, it can be replaced with a rope or buckle of the same specification.
